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## Classroom Norms

### 1. Be respectful to YOURSELF, to OTHERS, and to the CLASSROOM

- Treat others as you would want to be treated
- Academic dishonesty

### 2. Be a prepared learner

- Items needed each day: writing utensil, binder, book choice, chrome book
- Be prepared with homework & class expectations to further learning
- Prepare for assessments without counting on a redo - TRY the FIRST time
- No extra credit - school wide

### 3. Use your class and work time wisely

- Participating as a learner in class & in group work
- Sufficient time to do majority of classwork and homework

### 4. Be responsible for your own actions

- Your response is your responsibility
- You are in charge of your learning
- Ask for help when needed
- THINK before you speak

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## Grading Policy

### 5. Homework and Assessments

- Homework (formative assessment) will be worth 20% of final grade
- Only BEST efforts will be accepted
- Test (summative assessments) will be 80% of final grade
- Student initiated redo's on summative assessments will be allowed only after test corrections are made and students initiate an agreed upon time to redo the test

### 6. Late Work

- Homework & classwork is expected to be completed on time and with best effort
  - Late work will be accepted within the current unit of study only
  - After the summative test is given, no late work will be accepted.
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## Things to Know

### 1. Exit Passes

### 2. Study Day
